Conference goers to the Independent Sector Conference 2014 in Seattle, Washington were able to benefit from seeing firsthand the exciting technology at Microsoft Visitor's Center. Attendees got to see how Microsoft technology opens exciting opportunities for nonprofits to better achieve their missions and accelerate their impact.

The participants attended a thought-provoking series of sessions relating to Microsoft's "Technology for Good" program. Through a short video and Powerpoint session, participants learned about Microsoft's software donation program, carried out in partnership with TechSoup Global. Microsoft donates software to eligible nonprofit organizations and public libraries to help them use technology to further their missions. Offered in 41 countries worldwide, donated software includes Online Office applications, e-mail, calendar, HD video conferencing, and more. Next was a presentation on exciting technologies for Internet and online safety. The presentation included efforts employed worldwide to combat hacking, privacy compromises, and viruses. In this way, Microsoft can target security efforts, and people around the world can make better-informed decisions on how to protect their privacy. Lastly, a series of short video "snippets" were shown on Using Skype in the Classroom. Educators can take

on Using Skype in the Classroom. Educators can take students on "virtual field trips," inspiring them to make a difference by connecting U.S. classrooms with students and educators. Skype is live learning; it expands the walls of the classroom, giving students the opportunity to see and hear viewpoints not otherwise accessible to them, creating veritable "global citizens" of our young people.
