### UNEMPLOYMENT TAXES AT WORK-NOT FOR ALL **NONPROFITS WITH 4 OR MORE EMPLOYEES MUST PAY BY LAW**

It has been said...there are two things you can count on... taxes and death. Well nonprofit organizations are no different despite their tax-exempt status. They can be exempt from paving income tax however other taxes are still paid by these tax exempt organizations such as: FICA taxes, Property taxes, Tourist Taxes, and more. There are several tax exemptions available to nonprofits to apply for including: FL Property Taxes (determined by each of the 67 FL Counties), Sales Tax (Form DR5) and Reemployment formerly Unemployment Tax, (Form RT28G) to name a few. Historically, FANO conducted a successful six year advocacy campaign to expand qualification for Sales Tax exemption (for all nonprofits with IRS determination). FANO also successfully advocated to bring the Unemployment Savings Program to Florida to assist nonprofit agencies to reduce expenses by reimbursing the State for claims ONLY.
